



## INFECTION PREVENTION AND CONTROL POLICY

### PURPOSE

This policy outlines practices required to prevent or minimise the risk and consequences of Primoero personnel acquiring the Coronavirus, or any other infection, multi-resistant organism colonisation, or communicable disease (Infection).

### OUR AIM

- Continue to adhere to our mandatory obligations including those of the Occupational Safety and Health Act and the Privacy Act.
- Keep informed and implement relevant actions from authoritative sources of public health guidance regarding any Infection.
- Provide the sources of accurate and timely information to reduce or prevent the spread of Infection.
- Implement appropriate measures to prevent or reduce the risk of workplace transmission.
- Communicate this policy across the whole organisation through appropriate forums and mediums.

### OUR COMMITMENT

- Provide effective leadership in Infection prevention, minimisation, control surveillance and reporting.
- Prevent or minimise the risks and consequences of Primoero introducing an Infection to its clients, or any third party.
- Plan and implement strategies to ensure business continuity in the event an Infection impacts the business.

This policy applies to all Primoero personnel and contractors working across all projects and operations. The Board of Directors commits to ensuring this policy is enforced and communicated to the workforce.
